New Coordinators – Hired a Camp Coordinator and a Community Engagement & Outreach Coordinator to strengthen programs and community relationships.

We're expanding training to equip volunteers with skills in adaptive programming and to better support neurodiverse campers or those with complex needs, ensuring all campers can thrive.

Tailored specifically for 14-17 year olds, this program provides a vital space for building community and fostering connections. Many participants have shared that they face challenges in making friends and balancing the pressures of school at home.
